

Battery invented 120 years ago

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In 1899, a Swedish scientist named Waldemar Jungner invented the nickel-cadmium battery, a rechargeable battery that has nickel and cadmium electrodes in a potassium hydroxide solution; the ...

Alessandro Volta invented the first practical battery in 1800 using zinc and copper discs. The first rechargeable battery was developed by Gaston Plante in 1859 and is used in cars today.

However, even though the history of modern battery reaches back to the past only around 200 years, first interactions of mankind with electricity and simple batteries started much earlier.

At the turn of the 20th Century, Thomas Edison invented a battery with the unusual quirk of producing hydrogen. Now, 120 years later, the battery is coming into its own.
