

How many jobs are there in Thailand for lithium-ion battery production?

The Shenzhen-based firm will create 1,000 jobs in Thailand for production of lithium-ion battery cells for EV manufacturers at a facility that would include manufacturing, research and product development. Thailand is Southeast Asia's largest auto production and export centre, home to major carmakers like Toyota and Honda.

Will EV battery production boost Thailand's EV supply chain?

Narit Therdsteerasukdi, secretary general of the Thailand Board of Investment, said: "Today marks a milestone in the development of Thailand's EV supply chain, as having EV battery cells produced locally will significantly reinforce our status as a manufacturing hub for EVs and hybrids, and increase the country's competitiveness.

Are battery manufacturers eligible for tax incentives in Thailand?

Battery manufacturers will receive significant tax incentives in Thailand. They are eligible for a 90% reduction in import duty for materials used in production and a full import duty exemption for research materials. Additionally, those with investment privileges will receive subsidies for investment, research, and personnel training.
