

Brazil outdoor power supply charging voltage

In Brazil, the voltage is 127V or 220V, so please check if your electronic devices support this voltage. It is advisable to bring a universal plug adapter, as Brazil uses C and N type plugs. Note that the power ...

In Brazil there is no standard voltage. Most federative units (about 60 per cent of all Brazilian households) use 127 V electricity, but some other - mainly northeastern - states are on 220 ...

You're in luck-- your device is dual voltage and you only need a travel adapter. However, if it only reads 110V or 120V, and you're headed to a 220V city, you'll need a voltage converter (also ...

In Brazil, the voltage is 127 V running at 60 Hz, so check your electronics to see if you'll need a voltage converter, but I'll go over that a bit later in the article.

Use a Type N power adapter for Brazil if your plug doesn't fit in a Brazilian power outlet. The type of plug adapter, converter or charger that you'll need when visiting Brazil all depend on the voltage and type ...
