



Cement wood trunk press photovoltaic panel

Treated lumber last a long time here, well over the 20 year life of the panels, and this is just a test setup - wood is easier to change up and doesn't require concrete.

The company uses local contractors to erect the timber framing and to install the solar-panel system and electrical connections, which are typical for a solar installation.

The PV panels are mounted to commercially available aluminum rails made for easy mounting of PV panels. There are two of these rails for each of the sets of 3 panels.

Here is a video of the frame I designed and built to hold my 6 solar panels. I went with PT made with 2x4s and 1 4x4 all 8 footers. The size is 96 inches tall...

I'm hanging 3/4 plywood behind it all as a mounting base. I plan on installing a cement backer behind the inverter and regular drywall behind the batteries (to keep surface flush). Should I just mount ...
