Photovoltaic inverters are inherently low-frequency devices that are not prone to radiating EMI. No interference is expected above 1 MHz because of the inverters' low-frequency operation.

Inverters used in some older systems have been significant generators of RFI. The FCC sets the standards for how much electrical noise may be emitted from any electronic device.

While solar panels themselves emit very low levels of EMF, the inverters and wiring connecting the panels to



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your home can be sources of low-frequency EMF radiation.

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
