Solar energy is abundant in the landlocked and mostly desert West African nation. The facility is equipped with more than 55,000 solar panels and is capable of generating 30 megawatts of electricity.

Niger has started running its biggest solar power plant, the energy minister said on Sunday, filling electricity shortages after neighbouring Nigeria cut supplies in sanctions following a July coup.

RANAA will support the development of the energy sector through the construction of three solar plants in the Maradi, Dosso and Diffa regions with a total generation capacity of 40 MW.
