How much does a 7 kW solar system cost?

These costs are for a typical 7 kW residential system (\$19,873 average). Monocrystalline or polycrystalline panels are the most common types of solar panels. Most residential installations use monocrystalline photovoltaics (PV) panels, which offer up to 24% efficiency and perform better in limited space and extreme temperatures.

How much does a solar battery cost?

They store the energy accumulated from the solar panels. The price varies based on the installer, application and location. Batteries typically cost \$12,000 to \$22,000, according to the Department of Energy, although smaller capacity systems are available for less. In some cases, solar batteries may be more expensive than solar panels.

How much do commercial solar panels cost?

Solar panels for businesses. Commercial solar installations are a great way for companies to lower energy costs. Generally, installing solar panels on businesses costs a bit less per watt because the systems are larger, but the total costs will be higher. In 2025, the average cost for commercial solar panels is just about \$2.00 per watt.

How much does a home solar system cost?

According to studies by the U.S. Department of Energy, the all-in cost of a home solar panel system is between \$2.74 to \$3.30 per watt. ^{1,2,12} This figure includes the solar panels, the installation, and other expenses. Using these numbers, an average-sized 8-kilowatt residential solar system would cost between \$21,900 - \$26,400.
