Currently, Kazakhstan operates a 7.5-megawatt (MW) pilot energy storage system at a substation in Kokshetau. The facility is being used to test how storage systems interact with the grid.

Kazakhstan is taking a significant step toward sustainable energy management by constructing a lithium-ion battery recycling plant.

The project, considered the world's largest solar-storage project, will install 3.5GW of solar photovoltaic capacity and a 4.5GWh battery storage system. The project has commenced in November 2024.
