

What is a grid code in Malaysia?

The Grid Code is a set of technical regulations used by utility companies such as Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) and Independent Power Producers (IPPs) in the Peninsular Malaysia that serves as the main guidelines in electricity supply operation; to ensure the electricity supply in Peninsular Malaysia remains reliable.

What is the grid code for Peninsular Malaysia?

The Grid Code is a regulatory instrument used to coordinate various electricity supply activities of the electricity producer, operator, distributor and the consumer. The Grid Code for Peninsular Malaysia was first issued by the Energy Commission based on the approval made by the Commission on 8 June 2010 and by the Minister on 21 December 2010.
