To determine the appropriate equalization (freshening) charge voltage and float charge voltage, multiply the number of batteries connected in series in the battery cabinet by the recommended charging ...

Terminals for connecting the batteries to the power charger and the fire alarm panel(s) are located behind the panel on the right end of the cabinet (Figure 1).

Battery cabinets that are not supplied with an incorporated DC output disconnect device must have an appropriate disconnect device provided external to the cabinet.

The diagrams below show the basic operation of a rechargeable battery under discharge and charge conditions. The positive terminal is the cathode during discharge, but it is the anode during recharge.
