In January 2024, the City of Tshwane Council approved a plan to lease Rooiwal power station and Pretoria West power station to private operators for 40-year leases.

The Pretoria West Power Plant is located on a large (approximately 1.5kms from north to south), mostly open site, on the eastern edge of Pretoria West, the Power Station is a large and prominent building ...

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Rooiwal Power Station is a five-unit coal-fired power plant with a total capacity of 300 MW. The plant was completed between 1962 and 1970, and is owned by Tshwane Electricity Division.
