

What is KC certification in Korea?

In Korea, electrical and electronic equipment and components are subject to compulsory certification, and manufacturers must affix the KC Mark. However, as the KC Mark has a unique set of requirements, they are often unsure if their product falls under its jurisdiction. What is KC Certification?

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The purpose of the KC mark system is to establish a reliable mechanism for consumer protection, product safety assurance, and market transparency. Manufacturers, importers, and distributors must ensure that all regulated products bear a valid KC mark before being sold or distributed within Korea. What products require KC certification?

How many KC certifications are there in South Korea?

In 2009 the South Korean government consolidated 140 different test marks into the current KC mark certification. Products falling under the scope of KC Safety may not be imported to Korea without a valid certification, which is verified by customs during regular checks.
