

Specifications for lap joints of photovoltaic sheet pile reinforcement

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The reinforcement shall be as indicated in EPG 751.39.5 Reinforcement, except that the standard #6 hairpin bars may be used for small footings if they provide sufficient steel area.

The Standard Specifications for Construction, Special Provision for Pile Splicing, and American Welding Society (AWS) Structural Welding Code, D1.1 govern field welding of pile splices.

A lap is when two pieces of reinforcing bar (rebar) are overlapped to create a continuous line of rebar. The length of the lap varies depend on concrete strength, the rebar grade, size, and spacing.

The three joints in Figure 1--one butt joint, and two lap joints--show the differences in the flow of stress through the two joints. The butt joint includes a groove weld while the lap joints use fillet welds.

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
