Suriname's Expansion Plan ensures a reliable and sustainable electricity sector for 2025-2029, with a 20-year strategic outlook to 2044 with a 5-year action plan

The project, considered the world's largest solar-storage project, will install 3.5GW of solar photovoltaic capacity and a 4.5GWh battery storage system. The project has commenced in November 2024. [pdf]
