Note the use of “costs,” which is not the actual selling price, since this can be affected by a variety of factors such as subsidies and taxes: o Capital costs tend to be low for gas and oil power stations; moderate for onshore wind turbines and solar PV (photovoltaics); higher for coal plants and higher still for waste-to-energy, wave and tidal, solar thermal, ...
