

Wind-resistant pv distributions used in uzbekistan oil refineries

Nur Navoi is the first Masdar project to begin operations in Uzbekistan, with the company having committed to a number of other solar and wind projects in the Central Asian country.

The proposed PV plant will be built in a single phase, over a construction period of up to 12 months. The technical lifespan of the Project is expected to be 25-30 years, in line with international standards.
